Dear Maynard Festival Vendors—This is your vendor confirmation letter!!!!

The Maynard Fest is only a few weeks-away (10/3)! We ask that you follow the general guidelines below.

As a note of interest, we will not take any new vendors after 9/25, so if you know of anyone that is interested in participating, they need to contact us before that date.

- Vendor sites are located in and around Memorial Park, up and down Nason St. and on Main St. in downtown Maynard. Directions are below.
- Set-Up is between 7:30 and 8:45 am. Since Nason St. will be closed from 9 am. to 3:30 pm., all vendors must be at their site by 8:45 am.
- Upon arrival, please check in with Sarah or Karen. We will be at Memorial Park, next to the parking garage. All vendor spaces are pre-assigned.

Directions

From 495—Take the Rte.117 exit and head towards Stow. Continue on 117 through Stow until you see the Stow Shopping Plaza on your left. (The Plaza has a Citizens Bank, a Shaw's Market and a Papa Gino's.) After the Plaza, but before the old graveyard (approx. 25 yds.) take a left onto Pompositticut. Pompositticut turns into Summer St. at the Maynard Town line. Go straight until you come to a traffic light. At the light take your right onto Nason St. and a quick left into the parking lot under the garage.

From Rte. 62 in Acton—Take Rte. 62 (which is Powdermill Rd. in Maynard) to the junction of 62 and Rte. 27. Take a right at the lights (McDonald's will be on your left) and continue straight onto Summer St. You will see the Fire and Police Stations on your right, and a few yards down, you will see Memorial Park on your left. At the light, take a quick left onto Nason St. and pull into the parking lot under the garage.
